

About Takasaki University of Commerce

Incorporated Education Institution Takasaki University of Commerce consists of a university, graduate school, junior college, high school and kindergarten.

Takasaki University of Commerce is a social science university established and developed from a girls' high school in 1906 by its founder Tane Sato. Combined with its junior college, it is a small university with a capacity of approximately 1,000 students, and is equipped with an excellent student support system and learning environment.

The founding spirit of the university is "independence and self-reliance." With an emphasis on practical learning, students can study a wide range of fields including commerce, accounting and business administration.

In addition to classes to enhance academic expertise, the course offers a distinctive learning style to acquire practical management and marketing skills through collaboration with well-known companies such as Adobe and Rakuten Group, Inc.

In addition, 26 information-related courses are offered, including programming, digital marketing, image and video editing and information security. The curriculum is designed to help students become "information-savvy management professionals" needed in society.

Students learn organizational management, business strategy and human resource development for all types of companies, large and small, as well as venture companies. In addition to commercial law, students also study general management operations.

商学部 会計学科

Faculty of Commerce Department of Accounting

The Department of Commerce features "practical education" by faculty members who are active certified public accountants and practitioners from the financial industry. For 10 consecutive years (as of 2024), we have produced students who have passed the Certified Public Accountant exam, one of the three major national qualifications along with doctors and lawyers, as well as the Certified Public Tax Accountant exam, the Japanese commercial bookkeeping exam and other qualifications. Our students have been able to find employment in major companies by taking advantage of their expertise.

会計コース Accounting course

All students acquire accounting knowledge for medium-sized companies. In addition, students acquire advanced accounting knowledge and practical skills with a view to managing large companies.



金融コース Finance course

In addition to accounting skills related to accounting operations for different company sizes and industries, students also learn about finance and management, including fund procurement, management and operation.

経理研究所 Institute of Accounting Research

The Institute of Accounting Research is an on-campus double school specializing in the training of accounting professionals such as certified public accountants and tax accountants. The Institute offers a wide range of programs for students from those who are learning bookkeeping for the first time to those who are aiming for difficult certifications.

日本•群馬 About Gunma, Japan

Gunma Prefecture is located in the northwestern part of the Kanto region, surrounded by mountains and rich in nature. It is landlocked and the northern part of the prefecture has heavy snowfall and is known for hot springs and ski resorts in winter.

Takasaki City, where our university is located, is conveniently located in the southern part of Gunma Prefecture, 100 kilometers from Tokyo and about 50 minutes by bullet train. Because of Takasaki's proximity to Tokyo, the dialect is standard, making it an ideal place to learn the standard Japanese language. The city has many sights and streets of historical value, and in 2015, the Tomioka Silk Mill in neighboring Tomioka was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



住環境 Living Environment

Compared to the capital city of Tokyo, the cost of living in Gunma Prefecture is relatively inexpensive, making it an ideal environment for studying abroad. For example, the average rent for an apartment near Takasaki University of Commerce is ¥30,000 to ¥40,000, almost half the price of Tokyo.



Takasaki University of Commerce is a 10minute train ride or 15-minute drive from Takasaki Station. Takasaki Station is a major station where the bullet train stops, and numerous stores are located nearby, including large supermarkets, grocery stores, clothing stores and bookstores. Therefore, it is possible to procure many daily necessities. Eating out costs an average of ¥800 to ¥1,000, but the Takasaki University of Commerce student cafeteria, open from 11:00 to 14:00 on weekdays, offers meals from ¥300 to ¥500. Furthermore, the area is surrounded by lush greenery with mountains and rivers, offering a variety of activities in each of the four seasons. In addition, compared to other prefectures, there are very few earthquakes, making it a comfortable place to live.

学生生活 Student Life


A student cafeteria and convenience store are available to provide nutritionally balanced meals at reasonable prices.

日本語の勉強 Study Japanese

Takasaki University of Commerce offers a course called "Japanese Expression," which is available only to international students. Students can study specialized subjects such as economics, management and accounting while improving their Japanese language skills. In addition, small group seminars provide students with opportunities to improve their Japanese language skills through research, discussion and presentations.
